Student Rights and Responsibilities

March 2007

Disability Services collaborates with faculty by providing information about the rights and responsibilities of students with disabilities.



Student's Rights:

- To choose not to disclose the nature of a disability when presenting the accommodation letter to faculty
- Equal access to University courses, programs, services, activities and facilities
- For DS to keep disability-related information confidential
- Appropriate and reasonable accommodations, auxiliary aids and/or services to address accessibility needs
- To receive academic information in accessible formats

Student's Responsibilities:

- Self-identify to Disability Services to seek information, counsel, accommodations and assistance as necessary
- Follow DS procedures to obtain accommodations, auxiliary aids and services
- Provide faculty a Letter of Accommodation from DS and discuss accommodations
- Meet with a DS counselor at the beginning of each semester to discuss accommodation needs
